Community Music Center on Saturday, March 5, the performance, A Remarkable Journey, will include works by the aforementioned composers as well as pieces by Betty Jackson King, Mary Lou Williams, and Mary Watkins. The evening will also feature photographer and writer Intisar Abioto, known for her curation of the Black Portlanders photo project, who will tell the life stories of these women, many of whom had to overcome some heartbreaking obstacles to get their music heard."

"And so many of their compositions are breathtaking. Price's Adoration, one of the pieces that PCM will be performing, has a hymn-like quality, with long, stately chords that hang in the air like bulbous clouds against a dark blue sky. Troubled Water, written by Bonds in 1967 and based on the spiritual "Wade in the Water," feels rooted deeply in the ground and suffused with strongly felt agony and hard-won salvation.
