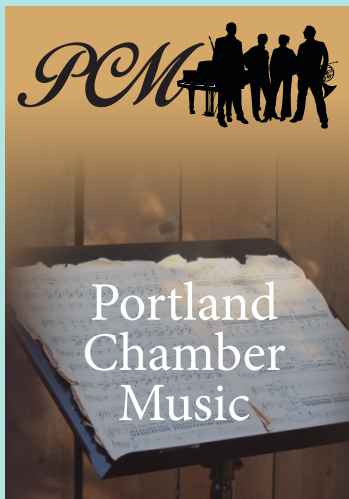

Our Winter Newsletter is being released with some delay.

In late November, Portland Chamber Music Executive Artistic Director, Anya Kalina, learned that both her parents died unexpectedly within 5 days of each other.

Both were renowned performers and professors living in Moscow, Russia.

Galina Arzamasova-Kalinina was an opera singer, mezzo-soprano, Honored Artist of Russia and a graduate of Moscow State Conservatory. As a leading soloist of Moscow State Philharmonics, she performed in over 25 countries around the world.

Pavel Kalinin was an opera singer, baritone, graduate of Lviv State Conservatory and a singer at The State Academic Maly Theater in Moscow. As a soloist of the theater, he toured all over Russia and many other countries around the world.

As voice professors they were committed to teaching voice at their private studio and also giving Master Classes in Russia and internationally through their last days.

Galina was the Founder and Executive Director and Pavel the Artistic Director of Musical Theater Festa di Voce in Moscow, Russia.

Pavel and Galina met in late 1950s as students at a Conservatory, got married in 1965 and were together performing and teaching ever since. Their loss has made a profound impact on the Moscow opera school, many students and family members.
